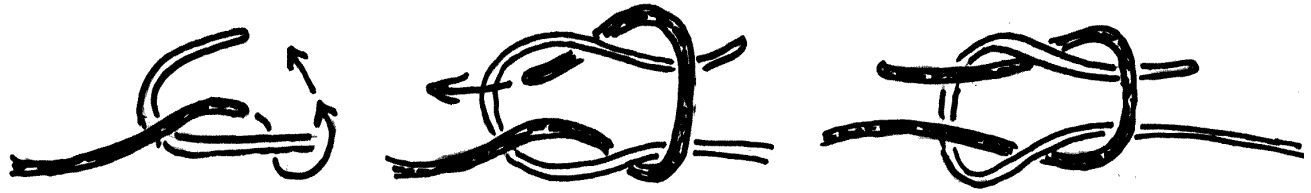


SQUARE KNOT



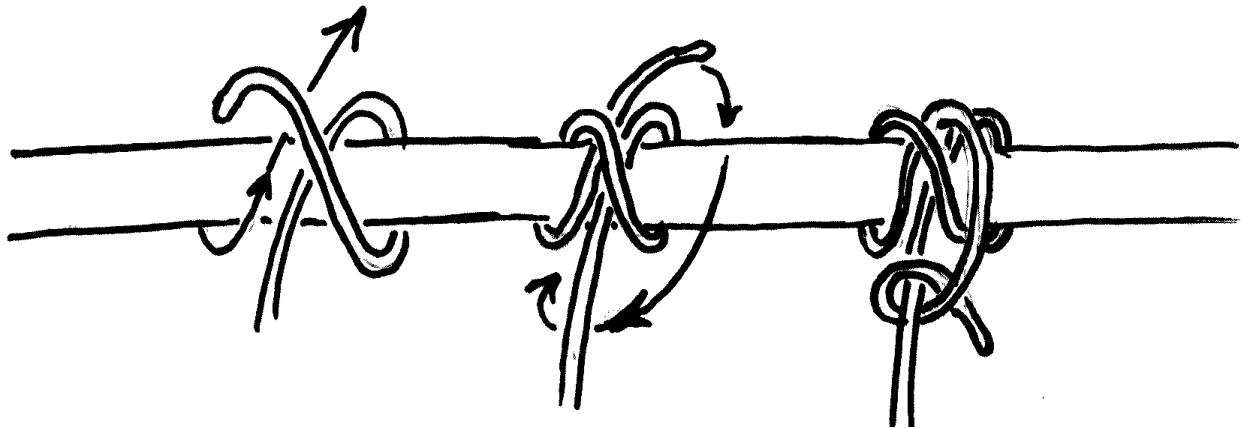
Used to tie two ropes equal size together.

SHEET BEND



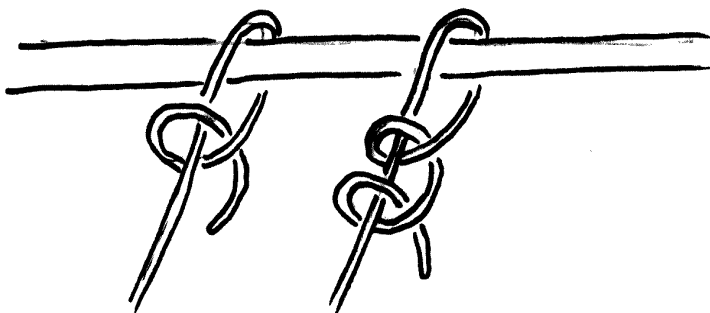
Used to tie ropes of unequal or equal size together.

CLOVE HITCH w/ HALF HITCH STOPPER



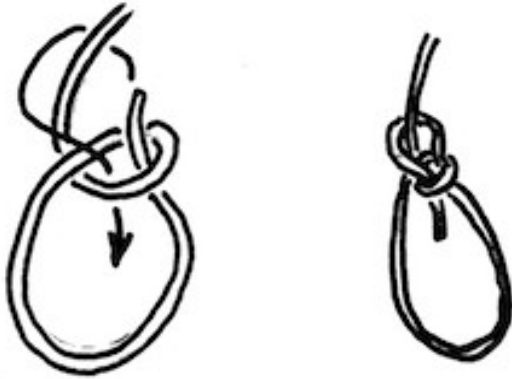
Used to attach rope to pipe or bar. Stopper prevents accidental release.

TWO HALF HITCHES



Used like a clove hitch. Not quite as strong but can be tied on a taut line or to finish off several wraps

## BOWLINE



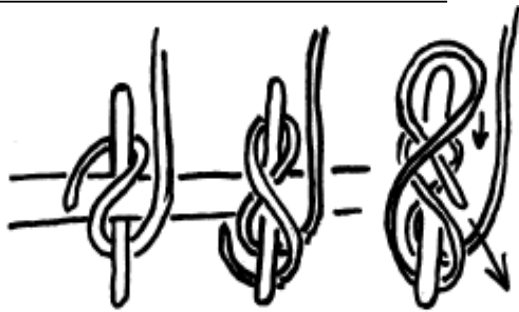
Used to tie a fixed loop in the end of a rope.

## FIGURE-EIGHT KNOT



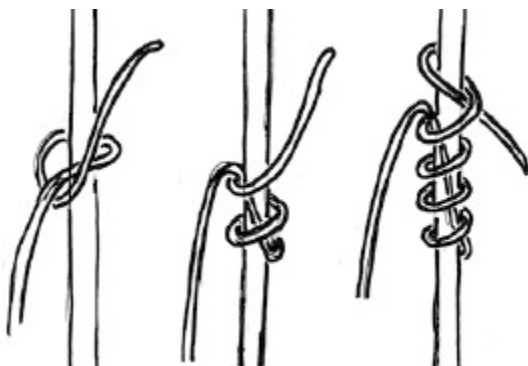
Used to prevent a tope from slipping through a pulley or can be used to prevent a rope end from unravelling.

## PIN-RAIL TIE-OFF or BELAY KNOT



Used to tie the loft lines to a pine rail. A couple more wraps than shown increases security.

## SNUB KNOT (Rolling Hitch type)



Used to secure an out-of-weight counterweight line-set to prevent the set from running.
